

Early Years Pupil Premium – EYPP (3 & 4-year-old children)

The nursery may be able to claim extra funding through the early year's pupil premium to support your child's development, learning and care. This can include providing valuable support such as extra training for the staff or resources to help raise the quality of your child's education. We may be entitled to receive up to £300 per year for 3 & 4-year-old children whose parents are in receipt of certain benefits. Please see below examples of how we are currently using the funds.
